Thank you so much for being with us on this journey and for making CFAN the network that it is. Here's to another year of collaboration, ambition, and impact in 2025.

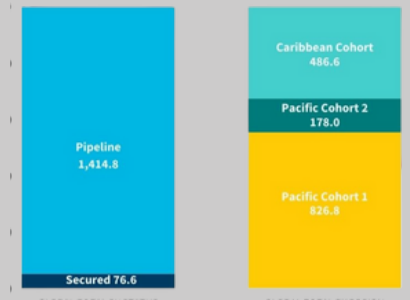
